### Application Guidelines

Applicants should submit electronically:

1. Cover letter addressed to Ramona Naddaff, Director, Art of Writing.
2. 1000 word proposal including:
  - a. The basic question(s) the course aims to investigate.
  - b. The unique writing component of the course and how the faculty member intends to teach writing.
  - c. The plan for mentoring a graduate student instructor.
  - d. Plans for using course enhancement funds, such as hosting invited guests, group activities, or research materials (\$2500 max.)
3. A preliminary indication of the syllabus and/or other material the faculty member hopes to include in the course.
4. A completed Proposal Cover Sheet.

Please send one .docx or .pdf document containing all of the materials stipulated above. The filename should include your last name, first initial, and "AWCG\_2021-22;" e.g.,

<b>Deadline</b>	Applications are due December 9, 2020.
<b>Eligibility</b>	Teams must comprise one ladder faculty member and one PhD student. All divisions and departments across campus are eligible to apply.
<b>Funding and support</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● One semester faculty course release</li><li>● One semester 50% GSI appointment</li><li>● \$2500 for course development by the grad student</li><li>● \$2500 course enhancement funds</li></ul>

<b>Requirements</b>	Courses are to be undergraduate seminars with a maximum of 25 students. Students, faculty member, and GSI are asked to submit course evaluations.
<b>Application</b>	Applications must be submitted online along with the proposal cover sheet.
